



VOTERS IN THE THIRD DEMAND AN HONEST PUBLIC DEBATE: KAT CAMMACK IS HIDING BECAUSE SHE IS WEAK AND SCARED:

Dear Kat:

Debates have been an important part of our electoral process since James Madison and James Monroe debated for a seat in Congress. I have [repeatedly](#) invited you to participate in a public debate on the issues, and yet you continue to hide in the shadows. I even attended two Clay County Republican events to engage you in a debate, and you changed your plans to miss these events so you could continue hiding from me.

Many voters have told me they would never consider a candidate who refuses to attend a debate or candidate forum. Indeed, there is no valid reason for not participating in a debate if you feel you are the best person for the position. If you can't face me in a public debate, how can we expect you to stand up to Nancy Pelosi, Chuck Schumer and Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez? If you are too weak or scared to debate me, you do not deserve the job.

Inflation is running rampant. The federal budget is deep in the red. Our values are under attack from Leftists and radical extremists. Our presidential elections are being stolen. We cannot afford to be electing weak and fragile candidates who run from conflict. Voters need a strong leader who can faithfully and effectively represent their political ideologies. They deserve better than someone like you – someone who would rather avoid debate, stand on a stage alone, and hide from your opponent because you cannot defend your conduct or political views.

I propose we engage in a 90-minute monitored fireside chat, a town hall meeting, and a series of three debates on three issues: (1) election integrity; (2) inflation; and (3) radical extremism. Let the voters compare our ideas and decide whether their future will be better with Manuel P. Asensio or Kat Cammack as their representative in Congress.

I know you are hiding from me because you cannot speak passionately and thoughtfully about the issues facing the voters today. Your refusal to participate in a debate is a clear admission that you lack faith in yourself. That is why I am launching a public campaign to demand your participation in a public debate. The voters deserve to know what they are getting, and if you will not face me in a debate then it is my duty to expose your cowardice for all to see.
